

Nominations for Officers - Elections - 2009

This notice initiating the IALEIA election process is the call for nominations for all 2009-2010 IALEIA officers. This Official Nomination Form may be accessed on the IALEIA website. **Only Regular IALEIA members** in good standing for at least one year prior to their nomination **may run for or nominate** a **Regular member** as an officer or director. IALEIA Election ballots will be available for all Regular members after the close of nominations on March 5, 2009. The 2009 election results will be announced at the April 2009 IALEIA Conference and Annual Meeting in Las Vegas, Nevada, USA. All officers' two-year terms will begin on July 1, 2009. Brief descriptions of the duties of each officer/director will be available on the IALEIA website. All candidates nominated are urged to provide the Elections Director with a biographical sketch. **All** Regular members worldwide may nominate candidates and run for all officers **except** as noted below.

Note: No name shall be on the final election ballot without the consent of the nominee. Nominees are encouraged to provide a maximum 200-word **biography/platform** for inclusion on the final election ballot. For International Director, authentication of citizenship and residence will be required prior to inclusion of that candidate's name on the final election ballot. **Deadlines:** nominations-March 5; biographies-March 7, 2009.
