Call For Papers

Henley-Putnam University publishes a peer-reviewed academic journal, *Journal of Strategic Security (JSS)*. The journal is published quarterly. The purpose of *JSS* is to create an academic forum for scholarship and discussion of the larger issues of security from a multi-disciplinary perspective, combining the fields of intelligence, terrorism/counterterrorism studies, and personal protection, among others.

JSS accepts unsolicited query letters, book reviews, and well-written scholarly papers on all aspects of strategic security. We welcome submissions from students, professionals, and scholars in intelligence, military, law enforcement, government, academia, and the private sector.

If you have a proposal for a paper or a completed manuscript, feel free to submit it for consideration according to the instructions below.

Manuscript and Submission Specifications

Articles should be from 3,000 to 7,500 words. Parties submitting an article or proposal should include the following with their submission:

- A resume or bio summarizing the writer's qualifications and contact information.
- A publication history containing a representative listing of the author's most recent publications.
- A query letter describing the piece to be submitted, or a brief abstract of a completed manuscript.

Please submit all documents in electronic format, Microsoft Word preferred. No hard copy submissions will be accepted. Submitted manuscripts should be double-spaced, in 12 pt. Courier or New Times Roman font. All manuscripts must follow the *Chicago Manual* format and style.

Please allow two to four weeks for a reply.

All articles that are initially accepted for publication are subject to peer review. The author may be asked to make changes as requested by the reviewer and editor before the



work is published. The journal reserves the right to make basic grammatical corrections should the author be unavailable, though any changes to content will be discussed with the author. Should the suggested changes of either type prove substantial, then the paper may be held over for possible inclusion in a later issue of the journal.

Only original manuscripts not previously published or under consideration for publication elsewhere will be considered. If accepted for publication, all manuscripts become the exclusive property of *JSS*, and cannot be published elsewhere without the written consent of Henley-Putnam University.
