



**ANNOUNCING THE NMIA/NMIF SCHOLARSHIP
PROGRAM FOR THE
2nd Semester of the 2008- 2009 ACADEMIC YEAR**

The National Military Intelligence Association (NMIA) and the National Military Intelligence Foundation (NMIF) are pleased to announce a program of scholarships to support undergraduate and graduate studies in the fields of or related to military intelligence. NMIA/NMIF will award up to three scholarships of \$2000 to qualified students for use in the 2008-2009 academic year.

Scholarship awardees must be enrolled in an accredited two or four year post secondary educational institution. They shall be either a declared major in intelligence studies or a closely related major, or be enrolled in a substantial number of courses directly related to intelligence studies or military intelligence.

All applicants shall prepare a short essay explaining their career goals and objectives, the course of study being pursued intended to attain those goals and objectives, and how an NMIA/NMIF scholarship would contribute to their success. Essays should not exceed 1000 words (approximately 1 page) in length.

Applicants must be eligible for college entrance in the Class of 2012 or already be enrolled in an accredited undergraduate or graduate degree program. Selection will be based on academic achievement (Grade Point Average), SAT or ACT scores, extra curricular activities, and the essay on career objectives.

Applications for these scholarships, supporting transcripts, and SAT or ACT scores must be submitted to reach the NIF Scholarship Committee by 6 December 2008
