Authors are invited to submit previously unpublished papers discussing theoretical advances, applications, case studies, or general knowledge on the ethics, morality or professional conduct of intelligence in law enforcement, homeland security, or national security (military or civilian). This is a multi-disciplinary conference and we welcome academics and practitioners from all fields of study. **The conference will be held on February 22-23, 2008 at The Johns Hopkins University-Mt. Washington Conference Center, in Baltimore, Maryland.**

Two types of contributions are solicited:

- Papers, requiring approximately 30-40 minutes for presentation.
- Panels, suitable for a presentation of approximately 15-20 minutes (per individual) on a common theme. The panel can either be recommended by contributor or proposed by the conference committee.

Abstracts, summaries or outlines should be of sufficient detail and length (200-500 words) to permit careful review by the conference committee and must be submitted **NO LATER THAN OCTOBER 15<sup>th</sup>**. Submissions must be sent in Word or Adobe PDF format via the conference website or e-mail: [conference2008@intelligence-ethics.org](mailto:conference2008@intelligence-ethics.org). Authors will be notified of acceptance no later than October 31, 2007. Final manuscripts of accepted papers **must be** submitted in WORD or PDF format no later than February 15, 2007. **We ask authors to provide a short biography.** *Selected full papers from the conference are planned for publication in a journal or book specifically focusing on ethics and intelligence.*
