- FIAT curriculum is guided by the **National Criminal Intelligence Sharing Plan (NCISP)** and the **IALEIA's Analytic Standards** booklet endorsed by the **Global Justice Information Sharing Initiative**
- The FIAT course is intended for civilian and sworn law enforcement, as well as regulatory personnel who have *not received* formal, basic, intelligence analysis training.
- Course instructors are IALEIA certified *experienced, working, analysts*.
- Course cost varies but is normally between \$500 and \$600 per student.
