How to Apply:

The application package must contain a minimum 1,500-word, maximum 2,000-word essay on the following topic.

**Essay Topic** 

IALEIA recently turned 40 years old. Explain the evolution of today's intelligence analyst. How has the role of the analyst changed in 40 years and how has it stayed the same? How do you see the profession continuing for the next 40 years? (Or, Where must the profession evolve to remain current for the next 40 years).

Application submissions must include:

**Scholarship application** 

Essay (1,500 – 2,000 words)

Letter from a faculty advisor or acceptance letter from academic institution, including the name, telephone number, and mailing address of the Registrar for the school you are attending.

Application *deadline* is midnight Pacific Time, February 24th, 2023. Eligible submissions must be provided in English and fulfill the requirements outlined above. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.
