

IALEIA 2020 Education Scholarship

Any active IALEIA member, or immediate family member of an active IALEIA member, who is enrolled in an accredited post-secondary institution, is eligible to apply for the Education Scholarship. Eligibility is based on full-time or part-time enrollment in an accredited college/university, and can be on campus or via distance-learning. The scholarship amount will be paid directly to the institution the individual is attending.

How to Apply

The application package must contain a minimum 1,500-word, maximum 2,000-word essay on the following topic.

Essay Topic:
What is the role of intelligence analysis in such policing strategies as proactive policing, predictive policing, and problem-oriented policing?

Application submissions must include:

1. Scholarship application
2. Essay (1,500 – 2,000 words)
3. Letter from a faculty advisor or acceptance letter from academic institution, including the name, telephone number, and mailing address of the Registrar for the school you are attending

Application **deadline** is midnight Pacific Time, March 1, 2020. Eligible submissions must be provided in English and fulfill the requirements outlined above. Incomplete submissions will not be considered.

NOTE: Only electronic documentation will be accepted by the committee. Essay must be submitted in **WORD PERFECT, MS WORD, TXT** or **PDF** format. Not submitting essay and documentation in the required format may result in your application being rejected.

Essays become the property of IALEIA and may be published in the Journal of Intelligence and Analysis.
